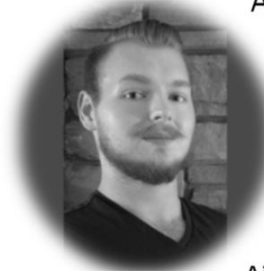

AIDAN HOGAN



Aidan Hogan is a cellist currently living in Wauwatosa, Wisconsin.
